Toolbar

Zoom in, zoom out and return to original extent.

Click and drag with your mouse to move the map around. You can also use the mouse wheel to zoom in and out.

In this map, demographic data is displayed using Census block groups. The information displayed is from the most recent publication of the American Community Survey (2017).



The Legend is selected in the toolbar.

To remove the window, press the "x". To navigate between tools, use the arrows or select a different tool from the toolbar.

Selecting one of the tools in the toolbar opens a window on the right side of the map.


The Layers tool is selected in the toolbar.

The Layers tool allows you to turn layers on and off. The arrows to the right of the layer name give you more display options.

Due to how the information in this map is displayed, you will have to turn some layers off in order to see a specific layer. For example: in order to see Median Age, you will have to turn off Median Household Income and Population with Bachelor's degree. You don't have to turn off population because that layer doesn't cover the whole county.

The Basemap tool is selected in the toolbar.



The basemap gallery lets you choose between different basemaps.

The Details tool is selected in the toolbar.

Flood zone definitions

A: Areas subject to inundation by the 1-percent-annual-chance flood event generally determined using approximate methodologies.

AE: Areas subject to inundation by the 1-percent-annual-chance flood event determined by detailed methods.

AH: Areas subject to inundation by 1-percent-annual-chance shallow flooding (usually areas of ponding) where average depths are between one and three feet.

The Details window has more information for the map layers as well as their source.


The Print tool is selected in the toolbar.

Print

The print tool allows you to convert the map into a PDF document which can be used for printing. The print tool will use the current map extent to generate the PDF. Use the drop down arrow next to the print button to select the size. Clicking the print button will generate the PDF. It will take a few minutes.



Some demographic categories are only available as raw numbers or other means (like the bar graph shown on the left). A pop-up is displayed when you click on a block group. Cycle through the information in the block group by using the arrows. Note, what shows up in the pop-up is dependent on which layers are turned on.

For industry occupation, hover over the bars in the bar graph to see the type of industry.
